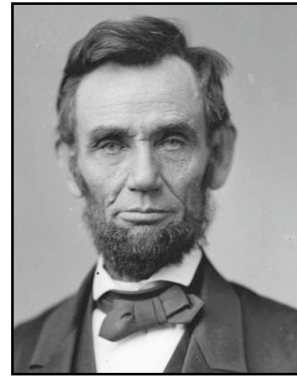

Virtual Gallery Submission Guidelines

By volunteering as the project coordinator, I understand my responsibilities to include the following.

-  Log onto www.lincolntoart.com for an overview of One Brush Stroke project instructions.
-  Organize and publicize the One Brush Stroke project for my group.
-  Coordinate and supply art materials and supplies to create Lincoln's portrait from the provided template.
-  Coordinate volunteers to assure a worthwhile experience for participants.
-  Provide instruction to participants and volunteers.
-  Identify someone who will provide finishing touches to your portrait.
-  Electronically submit a digital photograph of the finished portrait to janetb@pa-news.org for exhibit on the online virtual gallery.

JPG requirements for the photograph of your completed portrait:

- Capture on a 2+megapixel camera.
- Set camera for "fine" or "extra fine" resolution, not "web" or "normal."
- Scan the print at 100% and save as a JPG file.
- Images must be PC and MAC compatible.
- Approximate pixel size should be 1500 x 2100.
- Quality should be 300 dpi.
- Images should be at least one megabyte but no larger than 10 megabytes.
- The title of your file is the name of your organization.
- Forward your jpg to janetb@pa-news.org.

-  Send the digital photograph of your portrait as soon as it is completed; submissions will be accepted until March 31.
-  Include all of the following information with your electronic submission to ensure proper identification on the virtual gallery:
 - (1) **Name of school, class, teacher, club, organization or grade** as you wish your portrait to be identified on the virtual gallery.
 - (2) **Name of school district** (if applicable).
 - (3) **Your name** as project coordinator and contact person.

The virtual gallery, hosted by Pennsylvania Newspaper Association, will go live on February 11 and may be viewed until November 19, 2009.
